




## A breast change could be a sign of cancer


See your doctor if you notice




A lump or area that feels thicker than the rest of the breast




A change to the skin such as **puckering** or dimpling (like the skin of an orange)




Redness or a rash on the skin or around the nipple




A change to the nipple, for example it has become pulled in or changed its position or shape




**Liquid** that comes from the nipple without squeezing



Pain in your breast or your armpit that's there all or almost your collarbone all the time



A swelling in your armpit or around



A change in size or shape of the breast
